

#### FRIENDS OF CAMP COLTON FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The Friends of Camp Colton (Friends) Fellowship Program began as a collaborative effort between Friends and W.L. Gore & Associates Medical Products Division to expand the reach of Camp Colton's environmental education programs to a greater number of northern Arizona children. Fellowships are currently available to offset the Camp Colton tuition cost for rural and underserved schools in Northern Arizona and Flagstaff area schools.

Camp Colton is owned by the Flagstaff Unified School District (FUSD) and is a residential environmental education center that introduces children to the wonders of the natural environment through hands-on learning experiences. Since the program began in 1971, FUSD students have attended Camp Colton at no cost as an integrated part of their classroom science studies (expense offset by FUSD, tax credit donations and funds raised by Friends). Teachers/Administrators from non-FUSD schools in the northern Arizona region are invited to apply for a Friends Fellowship to reduce the overall tuition fee for your 6<sup>th</sup> grade class.

The 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Camp Colton Program:

- Accompanied by classroom teachers and taught by the Camp's team of experienced environmental educators, sixth graders spend four-days and three-nights at Camp Colton learning about and connecting with the natural environment.
- Camp Colton's curriculum is standards-aligned, STEM-based, and offers an engaging schedule of environmental science programs.
- Students also enjoy team-building and traditional outdoor activities such as hikes, archery, campfires, arts and crafts, games, and square dancing.

This four-day/three-night program is \$400 per student and accompanying teachers are free-of-cost (this price includes room and board but not transportation). To apply for Fellowship funds, teachers/administrators complete the following (or online) application. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis (via mail or online at FriendsofCampColton.org) for Camp Colton's spring and fall sessions. Applications are reviewed at monthly board meetings and applicants will be notified of funding outcomes within 6 weeks of their application date. More Notes: Friends will award Fellowship funds based on the number of students from your school attending Camp Colton and these funds will be transferred directly to FUSD-Camp Colton. One month prior to attending Camp Colton, the participating school will provide a certificate of liability insurance (\$2,000,000 per occurrence which names Flagstaff Unified School District as additional insured) to the Flagstaff Unified School District. The Arizona School Risk Retention Trust offers insurance policies for schools/school districts. Visit www.the-trust.org for more information or contact them at 800.266.4911. FUSD-Camp Colton will invoice each school for the remainder of the cost after students attend Camp.

#### FELLOWSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND REPORTING:

If you receive Fellowship funding from Friends of Camp Colton, you must submit at least one individual student impact story and a general paragraph about the overall benefit for your students after you attend Camp Colton. In addition, your 6<sup>th</sup> grade science teachers must commit to teaching the concepts in the pre-Camp and post-Camp curriculum (provided by Friends of Camp Colton).
